

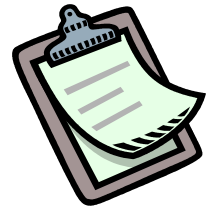

(Please ensure eggs are hard boiled or empty before bringing into school!)

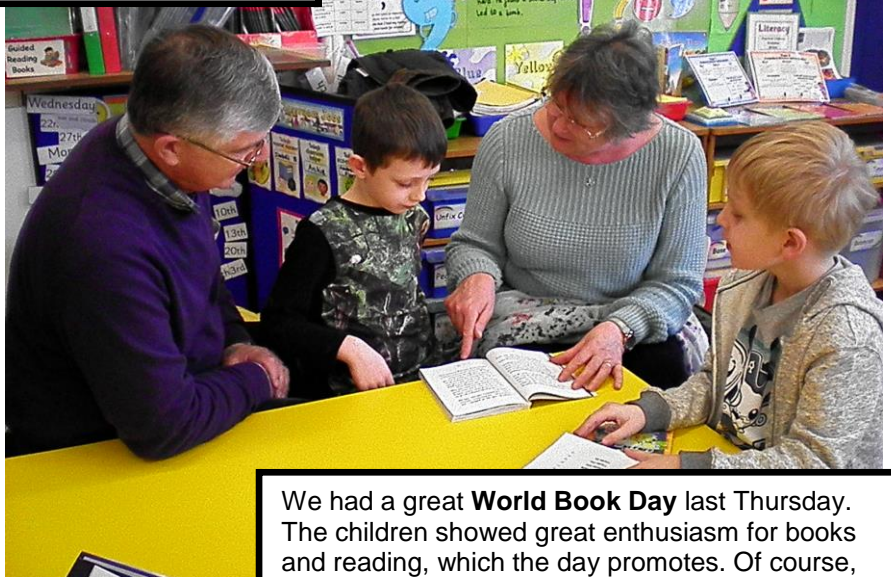
