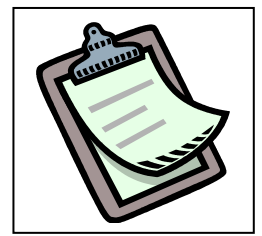

Collection of children at the end of the day...

BOBBINS: Bookings & Payments – How it works.

Bobbins take bookings and charge parents on a *half-termly* basis **in advance**. This ensures Bobbins staff spend their time with children rather than administering money on a weekly basis and also means staff can plan well in advance for food orders. All bookings are made on a booking form in advance, this is available on request from Bobbins staff or on our website under the 'Bobbins' tab. This needs completing to ensure your child has a place booked.

Should a booking be made and your child is off school due to illness, there will be a credit issued in lieu of this cancellation. However, in all other circumstances there will not be. This is because Bobbins is increasingly full and we need to ensure that this service remains financially viable by filling places when they are available. If the above is adhered to this minimises any embarrassment caused by Bobbins staff needing to 'chase' late payments.

Bobbins is provided by school as a non-profit service for parents but must 'break even' financially in order for us to be able to continue to do so.
