Su1 targets for homework for year one

Literacy Layered targets

- I can write a simple sentence.
- **Must-** I can write more than one sentence.
- **Should-** I can write a simple story.
- **Could-** I can write a simple story on my own.

Maths layered targets

- **Must** - I can count forwards in 5s.
- **Should** - I can count backwards in 5s.
- **Could** - I can count on in 5s from any number.

Targets for reception

- I can write a phase 2 word
- I can write a phase 2 sentence.
- I can write a phase 3 word
- I can write a phase 3 sentence.

Targets Maths:

- Finds one more or one less from a group of up to five objects, then ten objects.
- In practical activities and discussion, beginning to use the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting.
- Records, using marks that they can interpret and explain.
- Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20.

Homework Year one-

Spellings will be given each week. Children will be tested on a Friday.

Maths targets are set at the beginning of the term and children are expected to practice these weekly until they are signed off by the teacher.

Reading is to be practiced weekly also. Books will be changed on Tuesday's and Thursday's

Reception- will be expected to practice their targets through interactions at home and whilst out and about. Tasks sheets will be given to prompt thinking in different areas of learning.
