Feedback from the fair:-

- We did have a surplus of used toys and books so we will review our request for these in 2019
- We also suggested we do the School Tea Towels in Autumn 2019
- We agreed the leftover new Usbourne books would be donated to the school library
- We all agreed that books was a great santa gift and a suggestion was made to sell santa grotto tickets in advance of the fair so we can order the correct amount of 'presents' in 2019 to avoid the surplus – would also mean we could personalise the Santa visits
- Santa Stamps – some remain unsold these will be available again in 2019

Ideas for spending the Fundraising in 2018/19

- Idea from parent – 'Action mats' - www.facebook.com/ActionMats (*Action Mats are a quick to deploy physical exercise resource that creates balanced and exciting PE lessons and inspires children to get active!*) The school are going to look into the cost of these and speak with the PE Staff with a view of purchasing a trial amount.
- We agreed to fund new cushions and rugs for the school library
- Mrs Herbert also suggested that we have a number of the old Children's laptops may not be repairable so we will spend some funding on replacing these
- A parent had suggested that the school could exclusively hire Dragons Den but it was felt by the committee due to Travel and health and safety issues a 'treat' would possibly be better during school time
