

<u>United Benefice of Sutton with Cowling & Lothersdale</u>

There is lots going on across the three churches this Holy Week.

On Friday morning there is a 'Walk of Witness' by all the local churches starting from either St Thomas' Sutton, the Glusburn Institute or St Andrew's Kildwick at 10.00 all joining up at St Peter's Cross Hills for a short reflection. For the children there will be the chance to create an Easter garden. In Cowling there will be a 'Walk of Witness' leaving St Andrew's Church at 10.00 walking to Holy Trinity for a short time of worship followed by hot cross buns! On Friday afternoon there will be quiet, meditative services at St Thomas', Sutton and Christ Church, Lothersdale both from 2 to 3pm.

Then on Easter Day there are communion services at Cowling (08:00), Lothersdale (09:00) and Sutton (10:45). The services at Sutton and Lothersdale will include activities for children, including Easter egg hunts!
