

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for your support for the events that took place last half term. A few reminders/updates regarding events for this term.

Thursday 7th March 2019 – World Book Day + Fairtrade Bake Sale

A reminder that we have decided to do something different for World Book Day this year. Rather than the children dressing up, we have decided that each child will have the chance in school to ‘dress-up’ (decorate) a wooden spoon as their favourite book character. We hope to then treat the spoons so that they can be displayed in a spoon garden. If your child would like to bring in a book with their favourite character in for inspiration or bring in anything in particular to decorate their spoon with then they can do but there is equally no need for you to provide anything.

As you will have seen on our newsletter, Oak class will also be holding a Fairtrade bake sale on Thursday. If you would like your child to buy a Fairtrade cake/biscuit please can you send some money (up to £1) in with them. Any spare baking will be available for sale in the playground after school.

Friday 15th March 2019 – Comic Relief
