

Bike and Scooter storage next year

Thank you to those of you who responded to my query regarding scooter and cycle storage, and whether we provide this next year.

Although there were a limited number of parents who said this is something their children would use, we would like to provide this facility, as it may be something which grows in popularity over the coming years.

We are currently awaiting planning permission for a shed, to be built on the school playground. This is to accommodate the large amount of PE and games equipment we have in school.

If this goes ahead as planned, I aim to provide bike and scooter storage to the side of this shed. It will be clear in September if this is something we can provide.

Healthy Eating

As part of our work in promoting healthy lifestyles, from September we are introducing some changes around break time snacks.

From September, children will only be permitted to bring either a fruit or vegetable for morning snack. There has been some recent confusion over what is and is not permitted; this is made doubly hard by the high sugar content of many 'healthy snacks' such as cereal bars and processed fruit products.

We feel that by only allowing fruit or vegetables (e.g. carrot sticks) and no processed or packet snacks, will ensure clarity for parents and that all our children are eating healthily during the day.

Next year we will be working to build up the content of the website to make it as useful as possible for parents.

PLEASE RETURN SCHOOL MENUS

As you will be aware from recent letters, we are changing the way we organise school dinners. This is in light of our new kitchen build, which is due to be completed in mid-August.

As there is more choice from September, children and parents need to return their menu 'choices' sheet as soon as possible.

If you require another copy of this, please ask at the school office. If we do not have this by the end of this week, we will assume your child will not be eating school dinners when they return in September.

USING BOBBINS

For all parents

From September, please be advised that if children are collected late at the end of the school day and therefore require looking after in 'Bobbins', there will be a charge for this.

If this does happen, please phone us to let us know how long you are likely to be. If it is a 'one-off' then no charge will be made. However, if this happens routinely a £3 charge will be made each time. This is in line with arrangements at other local schools that provide this service.

Whereas we don't wish to penalise busy parents, we must also recognise the cost to other parents who regularly book their children into Bobbins.

For regular Bobbins users

'Bobbin Breakfast Club' and 'Bobbin after Club' will be taking bookings and charging on a **half-termly** basis with advance payment.

All bookings now need to be made on the appropriate form and payment received in advance via ParentPay, to ensure your child is booked in. Copies of the booking form are on the Bobbins page on our website.
