- Overall satisfaction levels remain high, with parents being very supportive of the school and its work.
- There have been marginal increases in parent satisfaction levels in most areas; although we recognise that many of these are statistically insignificant increases and decreases where they may occur.
- However, there has been a marked increase of 26% of parents saying their children are happy to come to school.
- More parents are viewing our website for information more than before.

Actions:

- We will continue to work in a targeted way to address individual children's behaviour. We will continue to access outside guidance and support to do this.
- We will make sure that all new members of staff are inducted effectively so that they are clear on the school's behaviour policy
- We will link behaviour management in school to staff's performance management and appraisal.
