### Friday 15th February 2019 – Wear Red for SELFA

SELFA is a local charity who provide support for families and children who are vulnerable, disadvantaged or disabled. They have worked with a number of our families over the years and do some fantastic work, including running SELFA Sutton for children at Sutton CE on a Monday night. Lucy Short from SELFA is coming in on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> February to lead an assembly explaining to the children about the work that SELFA does so that they know how their money can help; you can find out more about the work of SELFA at <u>www.selfa.org.uk</u>.
