Fallfest Cross Country Event – Saturday 22nd September 2018

Children from Sutton in Craven CE and other local schools have been invited to take part in the Fallfest school crosscountry competition, taking place on Saturday 22nd September at 1.30pm from Glusburn Institute. There will be 2 separate races:

Year 3 / 4 - short course (just over 1 mile)

Year 5 / 6 - long course (approximately 2 miles)

The route will run along Shutt Lane next to Glusburn School, past the cricket club and over the 1900 bridge into Glusburn woods. Year 3 & 4 will do a loop of the woods and back to finish at the cricket club. Year 5 & 6 will continue across the fields and around Bent farm, finishing again at the cricket club. The route is on public footpaths and will be marshalled at regular intervals to ensure the safety of the children. You are welcome to practice the route prior to the event and I can provide a map of the race should you want it.

Children will need to be at Glusburn Institute prior to the races commencing at 1.30pm. All children must have a responsible adult supervising them at all times prior to the start of the event. Team and individual prizes will be awarded for girls and boys.

I will then let the organisers know so that your child can be issued with a number prior to the event. If you would be able to help with marshalling on the day, I am sure that the organisers would welcome the support.
