Christmas Season Update

As COVID cases remain high, we want to be extremely vigilant in how we approach our Christmas celebrations. We understand that this will be the second year in a row whereby it is 'very different' to normal times. We want to really try to ensure that our children and our families have as 'normal' a festive advent season as possible. With this in mind, we will aim to have our EYFS and KS1 nativity in the Church with a live audience. However, St Thomas' Church has a risk assessment which we must adhere to. We are not able to have anymore that 80 people in total in the church. This means with our children and staff we can only offer 1 place per child. We know that this is not ideal but we have a responsibility to keep everyone safe. Please see below for additional information. 



