

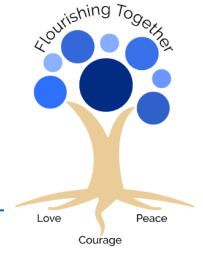

Please make sure your child wears correct uniform each day. Trainers are only to be worn on P.E. days.

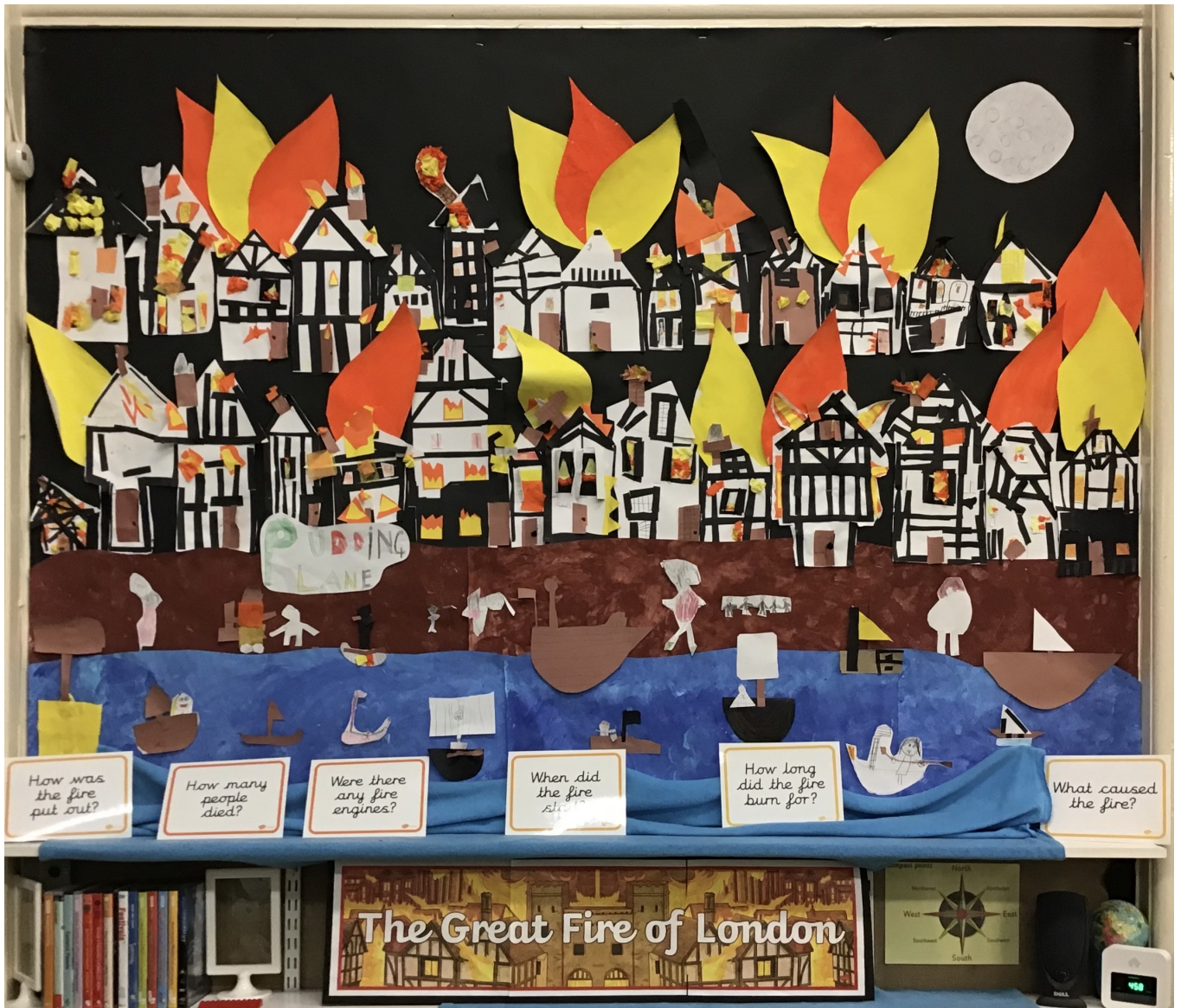
Please ensure that long hair should be tied back at all times for health and safety reasons.




# Supporting Your Child: Bullying
