Headteacher update

Well, that went very quickly, our first half term of the school year comes to an end and what a few weeks we have had!

From trips to Eden Camp to autumn walks, the children have not waivered in their ability to love learning and remain courageous in accepting learning challenges across the curriculum.

Blossom have been busy learning about the role of a school and 'being the teacher' in their role play area, Year 1 children have been focusing on comparing and ordering numbers in maths and have been planning a non fiction text about materials to support their understanding in science.

Willow class have worked on expanded noun phrases to apply in their letter writing. They have been working on problem solving and reasoning using subtraction of 2 and 3 digit numbers. Children have also been working across tens. It has been lovely seeing the children work independently on challenges that really demonstrate their mathematical understanding.

Birch class have all been writing letters to me that describe a portal, their enthusiasm towards this writing was fantastic and I am very excited to read each one to see where they take me! Year 5 have continued to work on place value and rounding to 100,000—they have challenged themselves with different investigations in order to apply their knowledge. Year 4 have mastered column addition and subtraction and have worked very hard on knowing their times tables. I am very proud of all the children—well done!

Oak class have had a wonderful first hand experience of what is was like during World War II during their visit to Eden Camp this week—it really did bring their WWII learning to life. They have also been busy working their way through long multiplication and division. This has really tested their knowledge and understanding of times tables and place value!

We have culminated our half term with a wonderful Harvest Service at St Thomas' Church on Wednesday morning. We would like to thank parents and carers for attending and for giving so generously towards our contribution to Skipton Food Bank. We would also like to thank Revd Helen for guiding a reflective service allowing us all time to think about the importance of Harvest and this time of thanksgiving and also to Sutton CE PTA for organising and running an Autumn Coffee Café after the service. Thank you to the children for their wonderful contributions of prayers, poems, drama and songs and also to the staff for supporting all the children to participate so actively. Thank you everyone.

I would like to take this opportunity to say have a wonderful, restful half term and hope that you all take time with family and friends. We look forward to welcoming you back on Monday 31st October.



Swimming is statutory and our children in Key stage 2 must attend. All our trips are intrinsically linked to our curriculum therefore enriching the curriculum experience for all children.


More details for trips and enrichment activities will be provided nearer the time.

48 Hour rule—Reminder


We would like to remind Parents and Carers of our strict 48 hour rule for absences linked to sickness and/or diarrhoea.
