## Back to school advice from UKHSA

Amid high levels of Flu, Covid-19 and Scarlet Fever, UKHSA has issued some advice for the return to school. Please see the attached letter from the Director of Public Health for North Yorkshire as well as the Back to school advice, 02 January 2023 for full details (link in the letter). There is no cause for alarm, but it seemed prudent to summarize the advice here.

To minimise the spread of infection:

- If your child is unwell and has a fever, they should stay home from school or nursery until they feel better and the fever has resolved.
- Continue with good hand hygiene
- Catch it, Bin it catching coughs and sneezes in tissues then binning them
- The flu vaccination is still available for all eligible groups
  - Eligible children include:
  - those aged 2 and 3 on 31 August 2022
  - all primary school-aged children
  - some secondary school-aged children
  - getting your child vaccinated against flu NHS
