Headteacher update

I cannot believe that we only have one more week to go until February half term and I am sure next week will be our best yet.

We have had a fantastic start to National Storyteller week with parents and carers visiting school on Monday to share their children's published writing and enjoy reading together. We are a school that promotes a love of reading and it was very clear to see this. Thank you for taking the time to complete our most recent survey on reading and spelling, Mrs Harrison will be in touch with FAQ's, feedback and next steps following the results. We appreciate your honest thoughts and opinions.

Blossom have been extremely busy this week looking at Six Dinner Sid—what a greedy cat! And using this book to help them to recognise and know numbers up to six. The children were all very confident at matching the digit to the numicon representation and also putting the numbers 0—6 in order. It was a pleasure speaking to the children about this and to see their understanding of the numbers. Year 1's have been busy applying their phonics writing lots of sentences using conjunctions. I am very impressed!

Willow have been learning about measures all week. They spoke very clearly to me about how you have to use units of measure like cm and m and could also tell me what unit of measure you would use to measure different objects. "Mrs Gibbons, you wouldn't use centimetres to measure the playground!"

Birch class have worked incredibly hard on comparing datasets and transferring datasets onto graphs, both line and bar graphs to compare the data. They have been comparing life expectancy with gestations periods in science whilst also learning the skill of drawing, labelling and using a graph to interpret data and answer questions on the data on their graphs. The children demonstrated amazing resilience and love of learning throughout these lessons—a joy to be a part of. Thank you Birch!

As it is NSPCC Number Day today, Oak had a very exciting maths challenge this afternoon, they had to show true teamwork whilst working together resiliently to solve each question to receive a code to unlock the padlock on the chest. There were many padlocks to unlock and I know they worked incredibly hard to eventually receive all the codes to receive the prizes! I am sure they will tell you all about it.
