It has been a wonderfully, sunny end to the week and we have all enjoyed more time outside. Let's hope this continues.

The children have continued to flourish this week;

EYFS have been exploring different movements in dance and the Year 1 children have been very keen to share what they have been learning about Martin Luther King Jr and segregation. Blossom class have also had a visitor from "Toddle up and sign" to support the children in their hook for their writing topic. The children experienced the story, 'We're going on a Bear Hunt' in sign language and loved it!




