

Attendance

As you know attendance and punctuality play a very big and important part in your child's school life. At Sutton CE, we are dedicated to ensuring our children get the best education possible and that means we will do whatever we can to support and assist our families where we can with attendance/punctuality.

We aim to work in partnership with parents and other agencies to strive towards every pupil reaching at least 96% attendance.

Attached to this weeks newsletter email there is a copy of our school attendance policy. Please could you take the time to read through as it details the expectations regarding punctuality, reporting absence, requesting leave of absence during term-time as well as the laws on school attendance.

Requesting leave of absence during term-time must be submitted at least 2 weeks prior to the dates requested (where possible) regardless as to whether you feel it will be authorised or unauthorised. A link to this form is here for ease. This link will also be on the school website shortly too.

Changes to normal pick up arrangements

If there is going to be a different adult picking your child up than normal please pass this information to the school office as soon as possible. If this adult is not known to staff then a password will be requested before your child is handed over.

If your child is in Year 5 or Year 6 permission can be requested to walk home unaccompanied (even if this is just a one-off) by completing the online form link below. Authorisation must be granted from the Headteacher before walking home can commence.

Permission is granted by the Headteacher based on a number of points detailed in the online form, including the basis that the children return home first have a "hand over" to a parent/carer and then the decision is made to go to the park from the responsible adult.

Permission is not given by school for children to go to the park, only directly home.



Bobbins

We are excited to announce that we are changing the way we run our after school club starting Tuesday 18th April 2023.

Enrichment clubs will run from 3:30pm – 4:30pm each day and then Bobbins will be either till 4:30pm or 5:30pm. If your child is booked in Bobbins, they will automatically access the enrichment activity. If your child/ren are staying for the Bobbins session until 5.30pm, they will be offered a snack from our new after school club 3-week rota menu. This will then be followed by outside play (weather/ light dependent), toys, Lego, jigsaws etc.





Summer Term 1 - Enrichment After School Club

We are excited to be able to offer a range of new enrichment activities after school. These will start Tuesday 18th April for all children. All activities will run for 1 hour, from 3:20pm till 4:30pm on a 3-week rota. There will be a charge of £5.50 per session.
